Re: Notice of Right to Request a Review

Dear _____:

Federal and State law grant you the right to request a review of your child support order once every three years. A review is to determine whether your child support order complies with the Texas child support guidelines. If a review determines that your child support order does not comply, the amount of your payments could be increased, decreased or they could remain the same.

If the other party resides in another state and/or the support order was entered by another state, the state with legal authority may review and adjust the order. However, we can still assist you with the initial part of the interstate review process.

Please keep in mind that:

- A review addresses only child support, medical support, and dental support. Visitation and custody issues are not addressed.
- The attorneys of the Office of the Attorney General represent the State of Texas. They will provide you with child support services, but **do not** represent you or any other individual.
- The non-custodial parent or the custodial parent may be required to provide insurance for the child(ren).
- Your child support order may be reviewed more often than once every three years, if there has been a substantial change in the circumstances of the child or a person affected by the order.

If you want to request a review of your child support order, please, sign the form and return it to the child support office listed below. Please return the form **ONLY** if you wish to request a review.
