Whether penalties and interest are cancelled on 1981 taxes that remain delinquent since 1982, but for which no delinquent tax notice has been sent as required by Property Tax Code § 33.04, C.A. File No. 86,043.

Dear General Cornyn:

This letter is to request your opinion on whether penalties and interest are cancelled on taxes that remain delinquent since 1982 if the five year delinquent tax notice has never been sent as required by the Tax Code.

Due to an entry error that occurred during the replat of residential properties, prior delinquencies were not transferred to the newly created property account numbers. Consequently, no delinquent tax notices have been sent to the property owners since 1982, including the five (5) year notice required by Tex. Tax Code Ann. § 33.04(b). The Code further provides that failure to send the notice required by Subsection (b) cancels penalties and interest accrued on taxes that are delinquent more than five years or a multiple of five years. Tex. Tax Code Ann. § 33.04(c).

Our specific question is whether all penalties and interest accrued to date are cancelled, or merely a portion thereof.
