RE: Clarification of Local Government Code § 143.006(b)

Dear General Comyn:

On behalf of the City of South Houston, I am requesting a clarification of Local Government Code § 143.006(b) regarding appointments to the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission.

In specific, § 143.006(b) states that the three members of the commission are to be appointed by the municipality's chief executive and confirmed by the governing body of the municipality. In the event of a vacancy, however, the same section states that the chief executive shall appoint a person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment. Please clarify the following:

- Upon expiration of a member's term, is this considered a vacancy in the sense expressed by this section?
- If so, does the appointment of another member of the commission need confirmation by the governing body?
- Does the municipality's governing body have the right or responsibility to appoint commission members without consent or approval of the chief executive?
- How many times can the governing body of a municipality refuse confirmation of a chief executive's appointment?
- When are these refusals considered a violation of the § 143.006(h)?
