Pursuant to Resolution No. 04-117, the City Council of the City of Port Arthur has requested that this office take such steps as are necessary as to obtain an Attorney General Opinion as to the usage of EDC funds based on the facts as presented, and unanimously voted on by the City Council and by the Board of Directors of the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation, in Resolution No. 03-371.

Attached is a copy of Resolution No. 03-371 delineating the participation of the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation and the City Council in the Target project. Also, attached is a copy of Resolution No. 02-367 approving the Target Grant and Sales Tax Refund Agreement, a copy of Resolution No. 02-366 approving the Neighborhood Empowerment Zone, and a copy of the signed Target Agreement. Please ask the Attorney General to issue an advisory opinion as to whether the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation has the discretion to fund the project as delineated in Resolution No. 03-371? House Bill 2912 modified the scope of the projects that an economic development corporation can fund. This bill was effective on June 20, 2003. of the issues is whether this project was grandfathered under Section 14 thereof.
