Request for Interpretation of the Texas Structural Pest Control Act; Occ., Code Chpt. 1951

Dear Attorney General Abbott:

Pursuant to Gov.'t Code §402.042, the Texas Structural Pest Control Board (Board) requests an Opinion as to the interpretation of the Occ. Code, Chpt. 1951.

The Board is having increasing interaction with individuals who deal with the removal of vertebrate creatures from around structures. This increased interaction has led the Board to seek an Opinion. Some parties try to distinguish themselves with their licensing authority. The Board during its review of this question finds itself dealing with these parties who often believe that they are solely under the jurisdiction of Texas Parks & Wildlife because of their practices. While the Board does not dispute the jurisdiction of Texas Parks & Wildlife, these parties are often performing trapping services in a structural environment.

1. May the Board regulate the removal of vertebrate animals from around structures? Occ. Code, Chpt. 1951.003 states "rodents" and "other obnoxious or undesirable animals". No specific animal control mechanisms are identified in the Occ. Code.
