RE: Request an Attorney General's Opinion

Dear General Abbott:

After the passage of House Bill 1717 during the 80<sup>th</sup> Regular Session, a question has arisen relating to the definition of a "device having the appearance of a fire hydrant" under Section 341.0357 of the Health and Safety Code. Subsection (b) defines such a device to be nonfunctioning if it "pumps less than 250 gallons of water per minute."

In portions of Hays County served by Aqua Texas, Inc, including neighborhoods in the Buda, Kyle, Woodcreek and Wimberley areas, this water company has painted black every device within their system having the appearance of a fire hydrant. Aqua Texas has done so without individually testing the flow from each device and admits that the flow from many of the devices exceeds 250 gallons per minute. In doing so, I believe they have violated the intent of the statute.

I would like to request an Attorney General's Opinion regarding the following two questions related to Section 341.0357:

- 1) In order to paint a device black under Section 341.0357, must the utility first determine the flow of that individual device to be less than 250 gallons per minute?
- 2) Does Section 341.0357 allow a water utility to paint all devices within a system black even when the flow from certain devices within that system exceeds 250 gallons per minute?
